Notice of Race for DF95 Invicta Trophy open event which will take place at Chipstead SC Radio Sailing on Saturday 2nd March 2024.

1. Event Schedule Registration from 08.45 on 02.03.24

Briefing approximately 09.45 on 02.03.24
Racing will commence immediately after Briefing
No race will start after 16.00hrs. Last Race to be decided on the day, dependent upon light

2. Location Chipstead Lake Chipstead Sailing Club near Sevenoaks Kent. Entrance from roadway TN13 2RZ. Chipstead Sailing Club Car Park TN13 2SD. Detailed location map can be seen on the Chipstead Sailing Club web site.

3. Entry and Eligibility

Entry is open to all MYA members and to members of foreign clubs affiliated to a Delegated National Member of IRSA. Preferably, enter directly on-line via the MYA Racing Calendar. The final closing date for receipt of entries is 02.03.24. It would be helpful if those who intend to race advise the above at an earlier date.

- **4. Entry Fees -** Event entry fees are £5.00 payable on the day at Registration.
- **5. Sailing Instructions** This event will be run under the current version of the Racing Rules of Sailing and the MYA SSI's. The Race Officer reserves the right to use Observers drawn from the competitors.
- **6. Entry List, Sail Numbers and Frequency Allocation** will be posted on the day at the venue.
- **7. Accommodation** There are a number of Hotels in the Sevenoaks area. Tents can be accommodated in the Car Park.
- 8. Parking Chipstead SC Car Park
- 9. Refreshments Tea & Coffee will be available.
- **10. General Info** Boat Launching from the Chipstead Sailing Club Main Jetties. A Buoyance aid will be required when on these Jetties. Some buoyance aids will be available at the Jetties entrance. Radio Sailing has its own jetties which do not require a buoyancy aid.
- 11. Competitors with Disability Competitors that require any form of help or special requirements should, prior to entry, get in touch with the organiser to check if the club is able to help with the provision of any such special requirements. The onus is on the competitor to establish whether the available facilities are adequate before deciding to enter the event.
