Sunday 12th May 2024 Notice of Race

This NOR is issued on 26th March 2024 and may be updated if required by new regulations.

1. EVENT SCHEDULE

9:00-9.30am Registration and Practice

09.45am Briefing

10.00 Warning Signal for first race

No race will be start after 16.00 and any race in progress at 17.00 may be abandoned.

2. VENUE Lincoln Radio Sailing Club, Scotland Farm, Eagle Lane, Thorpe-on-the-Hill. LN6 9BP

3. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The organising authority for the event is the MYA Midland District and responsibility for the management of the event is delegated to Lincoln Radio Sailing Club.

4. RULES

The event will be governed by the current version of the following rules:

- Racing Rules of Sailing as changed by the RRS Appendix E
- Equipment Rules of Sailing
- MYA Standard Sailing Instructions or as modified by the NoR.
- Class Rules
- HMS or RRS A4 Low Score System

5. REGISTRATION

The following shall be presented to the Race Committee at the time requested during the event:

- valid class certificate for the boat to be raced
- if applicable, the owner's valid personal sail number certificate
- emergency contact details

6. SCORING AND RACING SYSTEM

Scoring and Racing System shall be as per Section 4.

7. MEASUREMENT

The Race Committee may direct that boats in the event shall be check measured. Random spot checks may be conducted throughout the duration of the event.

8. FREQUENCIES

Permitted frequencies are 27 MHz, 40 MHz and 2.4 GHz

For frequency bands other than 2.4GHz, a minimum of five (5) frequencies shall be stated on the entry form and be available at the event.

9. PROTESTS

A protest committee will be appointed by the Race Committee to hear any protests arising from the event and may comprise competitors not involved in the incident.

10. ENTRIES & ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to all MYA Members.

Entries shall be made before the closing date for entries, 9th May 2024 using the MYA **online entry system**

After the closing date late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organising authority and may incur an additional late entry fee.

11. ENTRY FEES

The entry fee is £5.00 (for visitors). All Lincoln Radio Sailing Club members free of charge. To be paid on the day.

12. COMPETITORS WITH DISABILITY

Competitors that require any form of help or special requirements should, prior to entry, get in touch with the club contact given in Section 10 to check if the club is able to help with the provision of any such special requirements. The onus is on the competitor to establish whether the available facilities are adequate before deciding to enter the event

13. PRIZES AND TROPHIES

Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible at the end of racing.
